• Plant a Tree

• Young Tree Maintenance

- Newly planted trees require careful maintenance as they become established at their planting sites. Help TreeBaltimore partnering organizations work towards a city-wide goal of 40% tree canopy coverage by the year 2037! Becoming a Certified TreeKeeper in Baltimore City is a great way to contribute to this mission. There are ongoing classes covering the many important considerations while planting, pruning, and leading your own neighborhood effort! Pruning, mulching, staking, and installing deer or mower protection are some of the many tasks involved in young tree maintenance. The city's forestry nursery also requires periodic visits to care for nursery stock before they travel to their final planting locations throughout the city. This work typically involves arranging and mulching containerized nursery stock, large Balled and Burlapped trees, as well as small bare root trees. There is always a variety of these types of events running year round.

- Commitment: most events last about 4 hours
