CAMP DETAILS

The camp is located at the Farring Baybrook Recreation Center in the neighborhood of Brooklyn in South Baltimore. The center features a multi-purpose room (gym), dance room, arts-n-crafts room, full kitchen, accessible playground, two outdoor basketball courts and a pool. Programming includes aquatics, arts-n-crafts, sports, physical education, performing arts, healthy eating education, social skills building, life skills, fun-based educational classes, special events, field trips, and visiting groups.

The inclusive nature of the camp promotes knowledge and acceptance of disabilities. Additionally, the programming is geared toward developing lifelong leisure and recreational pursuits while also promoting social interaction, physical fitness, motor skills and most importantly fun! While the camp exposes campers to new experiences, it also provides them with a respite from the harsh physical, emotional and economic conditions they face on a daily basis.

Transportation to and from camp is provided for Baltimore City residents.

The fieldtrip schedule is currently under development.
